1. Position: Designated Assistant Professor
2. Affiliation: Graduate School of Law, Nagoya University
3. Location: University of Yangon/ Nagoya University Myanmar-Japan Legal Research Center
(Yangon, Myanmar)
(Ah-Di-Pa-Ti Road (Chancellor Road), Yangon University Compound, Kamaryut Township, Yangon, Myanmar)
4. Responsibilities: the post holder is expected to;
 - (1) Conduct research on Asian laws and/or legal assistance for Asian countries;
 - (2) Organize workshops, symposiums and other research activities on Asian laws and/or legal assistance for Asian countries;
 - (3) Coordinate student exchange programs between Nagoya University and University of Yangon;
 - (4) Communicate and coordinate research and education matters between Nagoya University, University of Yangon and other related institutions;
 - (5) Run administrative management and operation of the center;
5. Requirements:
 - (1) A doctoral degree or equivalent professional qualifications and experience. In terms of the field of specialization, law related area is desirable. We accept applications from those who can be described as near completion;
 - (2) Language competence in English and Burmese sufficient to perform the responsibilities described above;
 - (3) Language competence in Japanese as daily communication level is desirable;
 - (4) Experience in working at higher education institutions: desirable;
 - (5) Willingness to effectively perform the responsibilities described above by cooperating with students, staff and overseas academics.
6. Starting date: July 1, 2020 (negotiable)
7. Term of appointment: The contract ends on March 31, 2021, with the possibility of annual renewal up to three times until March 31, 2024 based on professional evaluation.
8. Salary / allowances: Annual salary system (to be decided pursuant to the Nagoya University rules by considering education and employment history)
9. Application requirements (all documents should be written in either English or Japanese):
 - (1) A full curriculum vitae (please attach a photo);
 - (2) A summary of research to date (2 A4 pages);

- (3) A personal statement to explain your motivation and aspirations for the post (2 A4 pages);
- (4) A list of research achievements. Items in languages other than English or Japanese should be translated into one of those languages;
- (5) Up to 2 copies of major publications. We accept photocopies or offprints. Publications in languages other than English or Japanese should be accompanied by a summary in English or Japanese, which needs to be at least one A4 sheet-long.

10. Screening procedure

- (1) First screening: document screening
- (2) Second screening: interview (Scheduled between May 8 and 13, 2020). We do not provide expenses for attending the interview. Because of the recent situation with a novel COVID-19, we conduct Skype interview not only for overseas applicants, but also those domestic applicants who find it difficult to visit Nagoya University.
